

#### FILLED WITH FLAVOUR

#### **Chunky Berry and** Artichoke Salsa

500 mL (2 cups) marinated artichoke hearts, drained and coarsely chopped 250 mL (1 cup) strawberries, chopped 250 mL (1 cup) blueberries 125 mL (1/2 cup) grape tomatoes, chopped 30 mL (2 Tbsp) red onion, finely diced

1 small garlic clove, minced (or 5 mL/ 1 tsp minced garlic) 15 mL (1 Tbsp) capers, drained 30 mL (2 Tbsp) cilantro, coarsely chopped 5 mL (1 tsp) smoked paprika Pinch of salt and black pepper, to taste

In a medium bowl, gently mix all ingredients until combined. Serve at room temperature or chilled, to accompany tortilla or pita chips, or use as a topping on baked or grilled fish, chicken breasts, beef or pork loin and/or baked potatoes. Store leftover salsa in a covered container, refrigerated, up to 5 days, or freeze in an airtight container or freezer bag for up to 2 months. Makes 8 (125-mL/1/2-cup) servings.



# Humble leaders

How you see others is a key factor for success

At a time when many organizations are struggling to hire and retain talent, widely admired leaders have an edge. They provide inspiration, not just direction. They enlist commitment, not just compliance. And they also create very healthy and successful organizations.

How does a leader gain such admiration? The following attributes come to mind: accomplished, decisive, strong, visionary, ability to achieve results. These characteristics are important. But another quality that is extraordinarily powerful in inspiring support is leader humility.

Leader humility is a tendency to feel and display a deep regard for the dignity of others. It offers great value, because supporting others' dignity is essential to create the foundation of healthy relationships. Healthy relationships lead to results. And results lead to successful organizations.

This all becomes clear if you consider what happens when a leader lacks humility: Relationships aren't strong and stakeholders are less inclined to lend their full support. There's less consensus and enthusiasm toward a shared goal. Employees don't want to stick around.

Research has shown that people have three key questions of leaders in their companies and organizations:

Who are you? Ideally, you're a person with integrity and a balanced ego.

Where are we going? You make clear a compelling vision and ethical strategies to get there.

Do you see me? How you answer this question plays an unexpectedly large role in determining your success. Specifically, what do you do to recognize that everyone needs a sense of self-worth (including your employees, customers and suppliers)? How do you and your managers bring people along so they can succeed in their positions and grow? Is it clear that your business truly believes its workers are its most important asset?

Answering these questions will reveal how much you and your organization support the dignity of others. In doing so, your business will achieve great things.

#### Hiring good talent


Are you struggling to hire good people? Most leaders know how to screen applicants for skills, but that is no longer enough. Leaders

e may still be a few years away from a humanoid robot that can wash our dishes and make our beds, like Rosie the cheeky robotic house-keeper from *The Jetsons*, but today's smart home devices are getting us pretty close to that kind of existence.

These gadgets let you easily control your home with intuitive apps (or by using your voice through a nearby smart speaker), and they can also automate tasks, like turning off the lights in a room when you walk out. Smarthome tech can also make your home more secure and run more efficiently.

#### Safety first

Keep an eye on your home (and your pets) when you're away with easy-to-install, internet-enabled doorbell cams or outdoor video cameras. They let you see what's going on via your mobile device. You'll be notified when they sense motion or sound, or if someone presses the doorbell. You can even chat with the person through your phone.

#### Wi-Fi thermostats

App-controlled thermostats can save you money on your heating and cooling bills. These thermostats not only offer you more control, they can learn your schedule and automatically adjust the temp in your home accordingly. Some models work with occupancy sensors you place in different rooms, for optimum comfort.



#### Smart lighting

Not only do LED lights sip—rather than gulp—electricity, they last for several years. Smart bulbs let you control them with an app or your voice. You can also set timers and schedules. This is useful when you're away, because they can turn lights on and off at given intervals, to make it look like you're home. Some smart lights also let you specify what colours you want.

#### Around the house

An intelligent garage door can push notifications to your phone if you left it open, so you can remotely close it. You can also open it for, say, a courier, while you're away. Smart electrical outlets let you plug in any device, such as a lamp or coffee maker, and control them with your voice or an app, or set schedules and timers.

Smart home devices bring us closer to living in a Jetsonian reality. ■

#### Smart home tips

Your Wi-Fi network is the backbone of your connected devices. For an efficient smart home, a new router

may be in order. The latest routers are faster and cover a wider area. If you live in a larger (or older) home, a mesh Wi-Fi network includes small, wireless repeaters to place around your home for better range. Make sure your router has the latest software (a.k.a. firmware) updates.—MS

hartered financial analyst Peter Hodson recruited me to work for Canadian *MoneySaver* magazine (CMS) in 2011. At the time, I was in my mid-30s, and Peter quickly became my money mentor and began, unknowingly, through day-to-day conversation, teaching me about the stock market and investing.

I recently reached out to him to ask about the lessons he has learned over his 40-year investment career. Here are his top tips.

#### Don't sell too early

Many investors like to sell when they have a profit. After all, as they say, you can never go broke taking a profit. But before selling, put yourself on the other side. Ask yourself why the stock is up and why people are buying it. Having your stock up is a confirmation that others like it. Why do you not like it? Are you selling just because it is up? Remember: Some stocks will rise 1,000% or more, with compounding. Make sure you are selling for the right reasons.

#### Don't listen to forecasters

No one knows what the stock market will do. The doomsayers have no greater forecasting ability than the optimists, but the doomsayers get way more attention. They get the most publicity when markets are bad, but this is the worst time to sell (generally) or to listen to them. There is always a reason to sell, and every single trade means someone doesn't like a stock. Nevertheless, the market has created long-term value for hundreds of years.



#### Buy when there is panic

The best time to buy is when others are panicking. Whatever the reason, every few years volatility increases, fear rises and investors sell. Going against the crowd usually works well if the crowd is panicking. Is there a war? Well, that coffee company is still going to sell coffee. A housing crash? Groceries and medicine will still be necessities. Focus on quality companies and ignore the noise.

Investing can be a tricky endeavour, and finding the right person to guide you is important, whether it's a trusted investment adviser or a money mentor. They may have advice that you've never considered. For me, it made all the difference.



#### Stay in the zone

A plant's tolerance to winter temperatures is reflected in its zone hardiness. Most plant tags, seed packets and other gardening resources contain growing information on the sunlight, soil type, wind and, most importantly, climate that an individual plant needs to thrive. Compare this number to your area's hardiness zone, which you can find on the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Plant Hardiness Zone Map (planthardiness.ars.usda.gov) covering the United States, Canada (located on the 1990 map) and Mexico.

heat of summer. Unlike annual plants that grow, reach maturity and die in one growing season, perennial plants—those that grow for multiple years in the garden—need to survive the winter cold to return each year.

Introduced in 2001, Canada's Plant Hardiness Zone Map (see the map on page 25; planthardiness.gc.ca) considers seven climatic variables, such as rainfall, elevation, heat, wind and humidity, for its plant hardiness zones.

The USDA Plant Hardiness Zone Map is broken into 13 zones. Each zone represents areas within a 10 F (about 5 C) range of the average minimum winter temperatures. These areas are then subdivided into narrower 5-degree segments. The lower the zone number, the colder the average winter temperature.

As you look at the USDA Plant Hardiness Zone Map, you may notice islands of warmer or colder zones within the larger









zone hardiness swath. Large bodies of water, urban heat islands, mountains and valleys influence the surrounding climate and growing conditions. These microclimates also exist within your landscape.

#### Zone training

Niki Jabbour, a gardening book author and Costco member based in Halifax, Nova Scotia, considers both the Canadian and USDA plant hardiness zone maps useful tools for gardeners, even though they are based on different factors. There is also an extreme minimum temperature zone map that focuses only on extreme minimum temperatures based on the USDA zones.

Jabbour finds most Canadian gardeners use the U.S. and Canadian maps interchangeably. On the Canadian Plant Hardiness Zone Map, her garden is in zone 6a, but on the USDA Plant Hardiness Zone Map, she's in zone 5b. The two maps

are based on different factors, but the zone recommendation is similar.

Brian Minter, a grower and horticulture expert based in Chilliwack, British Columbia, also recommends using cold hardiness as a guideline but reminds gardeners to consider the impact of larger bodies of water, elevation, soil type and more when selecting plants. In his province, he works with gardeners growing plants in zones 7 or 8 around the city of Vancouver and islands off the coast of British Columbia to zone 2 in the far north. Even those gardening in zone 5 can be surprised by an arctic wind blowing through and causing a sudden and extreme drop in temperatures that can negatively affect plants rated hardy for that area.

#### Braving the cold

To help plants survive the cold of winter, Bob Polomski, a Costco member and horticulture specialist at Clemson University in South Carolina, recommends identifying pockets of microclimates in your landscape where the temperatures may vary by several degrees. This difference can mean life or death in cold weather. Microclimates are influenced by sun exposure, existing plants and nearby structures. Colder winter temperatures generally occur on the north and northwest parts of a property and in low areas where cold air settles. Tree canopies, overhangs, arbours and fences also create microclimates in your landscape.

Use winter mulch to provide added insulation for plants that are not reliably cold hardy in your area and to discourage early sprouting during winter thaws. Cover susceptible plants with a layer of evergreen boughs, straw or marsh hay after the ground freezes. Use nearby plantings, screens and fencing to protect evergreens subject to injury caused by winter winds and sun. Burlap and other plant-protecting

fabrics can also be used to shield sensitive plants from winter wind.

#### Beat the heat

These resources can also help when considering the impact extreme heat has on plants. When temperatures exceed 30 C, many plants suffer short- or longterm damage such as withering, leaf and flower drop, stunted growth and more. The longer a heat wave persists, the greater the risk of damage.

Minter notes that heat tolerance has become even more important in the last few years. Areas in British Columbia experienced temperatures of 43 to 48 C during the summer of 2022. Gardeners are faced with finding plants that tolerate both extreme heat and cold. Plant breeders are working feverishly to select and develop plants suited to this change of climate.

Another solution, says Polomski, is providing afternoon shade and mulching the soil to keep plant roots cool and moist. When designing a new landscape, selecting the most zone-appropriate plants and arranging them to help create a more desirable environment can help.

Drought and water restrictions also make selecting plants suited to your area's rainfall more important than ever. Once established, drought-tolerant plants require less frequent watering. That means less work for you once these plants have formed a robust root system. Minter recommends creating a well-drained soil so plants develop deeper, more-drought tolerant roots. These plants are better able to survive winter cold, summer heat and drought conditions.

#### Successful shoulder seasons

The average last spring and first fall frosts also influence plant selection and planting times indoors and out. The number of days between these two dates defines the frost-free growing days in your location. Compare this to the plant tag, seed packet or plant description. Most of these resources spell out the number of days from planting to harvest or bloom. Match the number of frost-free days in your area

with those required by the plant.

Overcome this limitation by growing varieties that require a shorter season, start plants from seeds indoors or purchase starts to transplant for those plants that require a longer growing season.

Toronto-based Steven Biggs, host of The Food Garden Life Show, recommends choosing cold-tolerant plants so gardeners can enjoy gardening in the shoulder seasons. Planting dates, indoors and out, are also based on a plant's ability to tolerate cold soil and air temperatures.

Jump-start the growing season or extend it past the first fall frost with season-extending strategies. Use structures, such as cold frames, cloches and floating row covers, to protect young seedlings and transplants—or your harvest—from chilly temperatures and frosts. Jabbour uses garden covers such as polytunnels, cold frames and mini tunnels to create microclimates for vegetables, allowing her to extend the harvest into winter, but also to overwinter tender perennial vegetables.

Many gardeners choose to incorporate native plants, which are better adapted to their local climate conditions. Biggs recommends talking with nearby gardeners to find out what works in your immediate neighbourhood, as hardiness differences can exist within a small area. Visit your local botanic garden, seek plant recommendations from local university sources and consult with plant experts to help with plant selection.

With a little planning, your landscape can be an extension of your lifestyle, values and sense of ambience that helps reduce the stress of daily life. Wherever you garden, select plants that match the growing conditions, space, your design and the time you have to care for your landscape. That way you will have time to relax and enjoy the efforts of your labour. ■


#### Water wise

Water new plantings often enough in the first few weeks to keep the roots moist but not soggy. Gradually reduce frequency so vou will be watering thoroughly but less often. Watering frequency varies with the soil, climate and plants you are growing. Proper watering helps plants develop robust, more drought-tolerant root systems. Spread a layer of leaves, evergreen needles or wood chips over the soil surface away from tree trunks, shrub stems and the crowns of perennials. These organic mulches help conserve moisture, suppress weeds and improve the soil as they decompose and moderate soil temperature.—MM

# Tough turf

Artificial grass is a smart and sensible choice

#### **Turf selection**

There are many types of artificial turf available in a variety of pile heights and colour tones. First, choose a manufacturer that offers UV protection and backs it with a multi-year warranty. Next, consider the grass varieties found in your area and choose something that replicates what grows locally.

Costco supplier J. Sonic Services Inc. custom designs the shades of its Golden Select artificial grass blades to best match the natural lawn colours of the regions where it's sold. "Our grass rolls use many different shades of green for our blades, and different shades of green and light brown for our grass thatch," says Kyle Salhany, marketing manager for J. Sonic Services Inc. "We always strive to present product to Costco that is tailored to the country's needs, wants and environment."

gives an excellent balance between a lush lawn that feels great to the touch while at the same time looking like a freshly groomed lawn."

A lower pile height is also particularly appropriate for pets because the short, dense blade structure makes waste cleanup easy. If pets are a consideration, choose a variety with a fully permeable backing to enable liquids to drain properly. A permeable backing is also important if your turf will be installed around a pool or other areas where water splashes.

#### Cleaning tips

Once it's installed, maintaining artificial turf is easy, provided you follow a few simple steps. (For installation tips, see "Ready, set, go.") To keep it looking great, remove fallen leaves or branches before they become ground in; a leaf blower or lawn vacuum will make fast work of the job. In dry climates, rinse the turf regularly with a hose to remove dust and pollen. Clean spills promptly, blotting up with a towel and rinsing them with a mixture of soap and water.

Let solid pet waste dry before picking it up; afterwards, rinse the area with water. Liquid pet waste will drain out, but dousing with water afterwards is recommended.

Finally, brushing the grass against the grain in high-traffic areas every few weeks will keep it looking like new. Artificial grass is an easy way to improve your outdoor living space.

#### If you're after a neat and tidy, freshly cut look, shorter grass with a firmer feel is best. If you want a luxurious look, longer, softer and lower-density grass will give you that. Before making your final selection consider your lifestyle and needs. Will your grass see heavy use, moderate use or no foot traffic at all? Will it be installed around a pool? Will it be used by children or a pet?

Shorter artificial turfs stand up to heavier foot traffic and work well for families with children or pets. "The length of the pile height is a careful balance depending on the desired use," Salhany says. "A pile height between 3.5 to 4.5 centimetres [1.4 to 1.8 inches]

#### Weed control

Under the right conditions, any outdoor surface can support moss or plant germination. From time to time, seeds can be carried

by the wind or birds and fall on top of your artificial turf or where the turf meets walkways or stones. And rain may cause those seeds to germinate, especially in spring. If that happens,

the weeds can easily be pulled by hand or eliminated with vinegar and water, or your preferred weed treatment.—LT



#### Ready, set, go

To install artificial turf:

- Remove old sod, weeds and 7.6 to 10 centimetres (3 to 4 inches) of topsoil.
- Lay a sub-base of gravel, exposed aggregate or road crush. Compact it so the material is level.
- Measure your installation space and plan the placement of each roll. Always face the blades of grass in the direction of your vantage point. In the rear yard, the blades should run toward the patio or house. In the front yard, the blades should run toward the street.
- Lay out the grass rolls on top of the gravel base as you would carpet, stretching and snugging the pieces together, and cutting with a sharp blade. Secure with spikes.
- Top-dress small holes in artificial turf with silica sand for a more natural look and added comfort. Brush with a broom until all of the fibres are upright.—LT



# Into the weeds

Managing weeds in your landscape or hardscape

#### CONNECTION

You'll find landscape fabric, mulch, herbicides and other lawn and garden supplies in Costco warehouses and at Costco ca our garden looks beautiful after clearing winter debris and planting spring annuals.
But soon, pesky weeds will be poking up through those clean beds.

"Weed control in an urban setting is critical for overall aesthetics," says Jessica Enns, general manager of the Western Applied Research Corporation, a non-profit agriculture research group based in Scott, Saskatchewan. "Weeds can also compromise the structural integrity of your hardscape, including your pathways, patio stones and retaining walls."

Weeds in a landscape setting are a major concern for competition for natural resources. "It's important to get an early control of weeds to avoid an infestation that can cause overcrowding, which results in nutrient and water stress that can compromise the health of your desired plants," says Enns.

Here's a look at some options for weed control.

#### Weeding au naturel

If you prefer to manage weeds naturally, sheets of cardboard placed over weeds will help smother them. Landscape fabric, also known as landscape upholstery, works by covering the soil to prevent weeds from self-seeding and restricting sunlight that encourages weed growth. When used in hardscape areas—the non-living elements in landscaping—landscape fabric is best used under rock. This keeps the rocks on top of the soil and reduces the chance of weed growth between the rocks.

If your focus is to nourish plant growth but still reduce the weeds, mulch is a better choice. A heavy application of mulch can keep weed seeds from germinating, smother weeds already in place and eventually add nutrients to the soil.

"Weeds are plants growing where we don't want them," says Costco member Joe Omielan, scientist at the Department of Plant & Soil Sciences at the University of Kentucky. "To make life easier for you, remember to feed and water your plants, not the weeds. We want our plants to be more competitive than the weeds. For instance, only work in fertilizer or compost close to your plants in the flower bed, rather than spreading it over the surface of the whole area. This way the shallow-rooted weed seedlings will not have easy access to those resources."

Omielan suggests setting up soaker hoses in flower beds to direct water to your plants and not nearby weeds. "Remember that the size of the above-ground foliage we see is supported by proportionally sized roots. Mow your lawn at the recommended height for your region and season so the grass plants have roots deep enough for vigorous growth and drought tolerance."

#### Chemistry involvement

To minimize the harm to other nearby plants, it's best to pull weeds by hand or directly spray weeds with a solution of water and vinegar or herbicides. This is easier to do in a hardscape, where plants are contained. You can also use a string trimmer to cut weeds before they go to seed, along with a herbicide that stays active in the soil for an extended period of time and prevents the germination of weed seeds.

Herbicides and other chemical treatments should be used with care even in a hardscape, cautions Joe Neal, professor of weed science at North Carolina State University in Raleigh. "Don't use any herbicides on hardscapes that you would not use around landscape planting. The roots of plants will grow under porous landscapes, so any herbicide you apply will be encountered by the roots of desirable trees and shrubs," says Neal. "Herbicides applied to weeds in the cracks of non-porous hardscapes can wash off into the surrounding vegetation. I've seen dead turf where herbicides washed from sidewalks onto the lawn. The simple way to avoid injury to desirable plants is to use only herbicides labelled for use in the adjacent lawn or landscape."

Not all weed seeds require light for germination and some can escape natural control measures like landscape fabric or mulch. And not all weed seeds are controlled by the herbicides in weed and feed products. Weed killers, or postemergence herbicides, are chemical applications that will kill existing weeds. "Each type of herbicide has its unique properties and uses," says Neal. "Before using any herbicide, do your research to make sure you are using the right product for the task."

Decide what you want to accomplish in your garden or hardscape, and take the surrounding area into account. Then choose the proper product, to achieve selective weed control and a healthy and attractive garden. "It is important to use them as directed on the label," says Omielan. "It's always best to ask for advice ahead of time rather than having to deal with the consequences of a misapplied product."


#### Types of mulches

Choose a mulch depending on your particular needs, including weed control, aesthetics, size of the area, duration of the mulch, etc.

Mulches fall into two broad categories: organic mulches and synthetic mulches. Organic mulches are any type of mulch that was once alive: leaves, wood chips, straw (never use hay—it is full of weed seeds), sawdust, coconut fibre, grasses or bark. If organic mulch is applied directly on the soil, it will break down into the soil and supply nutrients for the plant's roots.

Synthetic mulches combine bonding agents with natural or synthetic fibres and are made of ground rubber, landscape glass, plastic or other materials. Some are made with recycled materials such as tires, but others are specially produced as mulch.—RWW

#### It's time to get all fired up about the new Kirkland Signature propane gas grills

et ready to get your grill on this summer, because the new Kirkland Signature<sup>™</sup> propane gas grills are coming to Costco warehouses and Costco.ca. The six-, seven- and 12-burner grills feature some of the newest advancements in outdoor cooking, such as LED knobs, an innovative grease management system and a top sear infrared burner that will immediately upgrade anyone's grilling game.

#### **Enduring quality**

One thing was clear from the beginning: These grills were going to be a premium product and made to last. No one wants a grill that lasts only one summer, which is why the grills are built with a grade of stainless steel specifically chosen for its high level of corrosion resistance.

While there are many grades of stainless steel, the three most used in grill manufacturing are 304, 445 and 430; 304 will not corrode in normal atmospheric conditions, 445 is corrosion-resistant and 430 is the most affordable (not to mention pretty and shiny) but not as long-lasting.

"We wanted to have as much 304 stainless steel in this grill as we could, because 304 stainless steel is what will have the most longevity and is the most resistant to rust," says Samra. "These grills are going to be a staple in your outdoor cooking environment for many years to come. That's what members expect from a Kirkland Signature product."

The hood, cooking grates and warming rack, and firebox are all constructed from 304 stainless steel. What's more, special attention has been given to each component. It's the Costco way.

"For us it's really all about quality everything down to the hinge, the casters, the thickness of each and every single piece," says Samra. "We go into all of those details to make sure it's a premium-quality product for our members. These are the kind of grills that are typically sold at specialty retailers."

# eat and cheese boards and grazing tables are perfect for a variety of appetites when hosting a get-together or party, but don't forget dessert. Themed dessert boards and tables lined with a variety of sweets will have guests as excited as children on their birthdays.

#### **Dessert boards and tables**

A dessert board is designed with the same concept as a charcuterie board but is focused on sweets. The desserts can be homemade or store-bought, individually wrapped servings or a cake that's ready to slice. You can find a rainbow of options. "A dessert board is the perfect dessert for those who don't want to bake or make anything from scratch," says Eden Passante, a Costco member and blogger at Sugarandcharm.com.

A dessert table, or dessert buffet, also known as a Viennese table, is perfect for a large crowd. If you wish,

#### What to serve

Passante suggests planning 142 grams (5 ounces) of dessert for each guest. With that in mind, chocolate-dipped crackers, cake pops, cupcakes, macarons, mints, caramelor chocolate-drizzled popcorn, fresh or dehydrated fruit, chocolate-covered nuts, mini cakes or doughnuts are all welcome choices.

Add wrapped chocolates and candies that fit your colour scheme and theme, and jars of melted caramel, chocolate or hazelnut spread for dipping, and you have a good group of ingredients to make a tasty board or dessert table. Edible-image cookies can personalize the event and be a sweet takeaway, particularly for special events such as weddings and baby showers.

If you love sweets but don't want leftovers, provide themed to-go bags that guests can fill up before they wave goodbye. Because dessert boards and tables can be so much fun, you might even consider serving dessert first.



# Sweet and sappy

Maple syrup is as versatile as it is delicious

You'll find pure Canadian maple syrup in Costco warehouses and at Costco.ca. Groceries are available for delivery through Costco Grocery at Costco.ca. lthough pancakes and waffles receive the most love when it comes to maple syrup, this refrigerator staple offers more than meets the eye.

Useful in marinades, sauces and even cocktails, maple syrup is a culinary all-star.

Made in late winter and early spring, this syrup is produced when the sap in maple trees is collected by sugar makers, boiled down and concentrated. "It takes 40 gallons [150 litres] of sap to make 1 gallon [3.8 litres] of syrup," says Katie Webster, a Vermont-based Costco member and recipe developer.

Maple syrup offers a caramel-forward, sweet flavour profile with notes of "vanilla, which makes it a very light sugar," says Camille Gagnon, quality and environment director of Lantic, which supplies maple syrup to Costco through The Maple Treat Corporation in Quebec. Syrup can exhibit different flavours, depending on its classification.

Grade A syrup labelled for retail is divided into four colour-based categories: Golden, Amber, Dark and Very Dark, says freelance chef and food journalist Suzanne Podhaizer. Gagnon adds that, once opened, maple syrup should be stored in the refrigerator and used within six months.

When cooking with maple syrup, Podhaizer, who lives in Vermont, says to swap for sugar at a one-to-one ratio, but reduce the volume of other liquids. She suggests cutting out around 60 millilitres (¼ cup) of another liquid for every 250 millilitres (1 cup) of syrup used.

Podhaizer boosts sweet and savoury dishes with maple syrup. She uses it in carrot cake, replacing the sugar; in tamari-based dipping sauces; and in barbecue sauces.

Webster doesn't shy away from being creative with maple syrup. She adds it to pad thai, sauces, stir-fries, marinades and dressings; bakes with it; and pours it over ice cream. And don't forget cocktails. She suggests reinventing a classic: "I love making a Maple Old-Fashioned with maple instead of a sugar cube." I'll raise a glass to that.

#### **Pouding Chômeur with Pure Maple Sauce**

500 mL (2 cups) pure maple syrup 375 mL (1½ cups) light brown sugar 375 mL (1½ cups) heavy cream 125 mL (1/2 cup) butter, softened 15 mL (1 Tbsp) pure vanilla extract 2 mL (1/2 tsp) salt

125 mL (1/2 cup) butter, softened 180 mL (3/4 cup) sugar 2 large eggs, at room temperature 375 mL (11/2 cups) flour 60 mL (1/4 cup) cornstarch 10 mL (2 tsp) baking powder 2 mL (1/2 tsp) salt 180 mL (3/4 cup) buttermilk, at room temperature 5 mL (1 tsp) vanilla extract

Preheat oven to 180 C (350 F).

Prepare the sauce: Combine all sauce ingredients in a medium saucepan; cook over medium heat, stirring from time to time, until the butter is melted and sugar is dissolved. Turn the heat off and reserve.

Prepare the cake: In a large mixing bowl, cream the butter and the sugar with an electric mixer until light, about 5 minutes. Add the eggs; resume mixing until fluffy, about 2 minutes.

In a separate bowl, mix the flour, cornstarch, baking powder and salt until very well combined. Separately, mix the buttermilk and vanilla.

Add a third of the dry ingredients to the creamed mixture. Mix on low speed until barely incorporated, then pour in half the buttermilk-vanilla mixture; resume mixing on low speed until just combined. Repeat with a third of the dry ingredients, then the buttermilk-vanilla mixture, and finally add the rest of the dry ingredients.

Transfer the batter to a 23-cm (9-inch) square baking dish-make sure that the dish is at least 6.5 cm (2½ inches) high—and spread lightly to the edge.

Delicately pour the reserved maple sauce over the batter, placing a spoon under the stream of sauce to help break its fall. Bake for 40 to 45 minutes, or until the top is beautifully golden and completely set. Remove the cake from the oven. Cool for a few hours before serving. Makes 12 to 16 servings.

#### **Maple-Glazed Salmon**

60 mL (1/4 cup) pure maple syrup 45 mL (3 Tbsp) soy sauce 15 mL (1 Tbsp) Dijon mustard 2 garlic cloves, minced 4 salmon fillets (454 g/1 lb total)

Preheat oven to 190 C (375 F). Line a rimmed baking sheet with parchment.

In a small bowl, whisk together the maple syrup, soy sauce, mustard and garlic.

Place the salmon on the baking sheet. Pour on about a third of the maple glaze, reserving the rest for later. Bake salmon for 15 to 20 minutes, just until opaque throughout, adding a third more of the glaze after the first 10 minutes. When the salmon is cooked, remove from oven and top with the remaining glaze before serving. Makes 4 servings.



# Shoulder the pain

Learn what you can do to protect your body's most moveable joint

A variety of over-the-counter anti-inflammatory medications and topical pain treatments are available in Costco warehouses and at Costco.ca.

ccording to Harvard Health Publishing, "The shoulder is prone to developing pain in part because its anatomy is complex and because it has the largest range of motion of any joint in the body," which means anybody can and likely will experience problems. "Three out of four Canadians will experience shoulder pain at some point in their lives," says Dr. George S. Athwal, a shoulder surgeon and professor at Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry at Western University in London, Ontario.

Since the shoulder has a complex structure with lots of parts, including four joints, there's much that can go wrong. "This mobility comes from the shoulder joint's unique bony shape, which is made up of a ball [the humeral head that rests in a shallow bony socket [the glenoid] on the outside part of the shoulder blade," Athwal explains. "As the socket is shallow, it relies on soft tissues, such as ligaments, tendons and muscles, to keep the shoulder in joint and stable."

#### Falls, aging, injury, and accidents

Shoulder pain is mainly caused by the wear and tear that comes with aging, or, in younger patients, injury, accidents and sports.

"Falls and accidents, especially those with high impact and trauma, can at the very least lead to inflammation and pain in the shoulder," as well as "fractures, dislocations or large rotator cuff tears that may require surgery to fix," says Dr. Uma Srikumaran, an associate professor of orthopedic surgery at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine.

#### Weekend warriors

"Sports injuries usually fall into the repetitive-use category [such as tennis or lifting weights] and can lead to faster degeneration of tissues than in the general population," Srikumaran says. "This may lead to more frequent pain related to inflammation or may accelerate the need to have surgery due to causing tears in the rotator cuff or labrum [a thick piece of tissue attached to the rim of the shoulder socket that helps keep the ball of the joint in place]."

#### **Common injuries**

Rotator cuff tendinitis is the most common shoulder condition. Athwal says. "It is an inflammation or irritation of the rotator cuff tendons, which causes pain on the outside part of the shoulder when the arm is lifted," he explains. It is often accompanied by subacromial bursitis and impingement syndrome. Rotator cuff tears, shoulder dislocations and arthritis frequently contribute to shoulder pain, as well.

#### Diagnosis and treatment

Diagnosis begins with a patient history and physical examination, including how and when the pain started and what makes it better or worse, Athwal says. He notes, "Almost all shoulder conditions can be initially diagnosed by your family physician or primary care provider." After taking a medical history, the doctor does a physical exam to assess range of motion and strength. "Commonly, a shoulder X-ray is done to look at the bones, how they are positioned and if there is any arthritis," Athwal explains. The doctor may also order extra tests like ultrasound. CT scan or MRI to take a closer look.

There are many ways to treat shoulder pain, and in most cases doctors use nonsurgical treatments first. These treatments are often started by a primary care physician and can include physiotherapy, rest, anti-inflammatory medications, pain medications and injections, Athwal says.

#### Surgery

If a patient has degenerative-type injuries. Srikumaran tries conservative management first. If the patient continues to have pain, issues with everyday activities and/or difficulty sleeping, the doctor will start a conversation about why surgery may be indicated. Some kinds of injuries, though, need immediate surgery, especially if the injury "will likely negatively affect a patient's function immediately or in the future." This includes dislocations, large rotator cuff tears and shoulder fractures.

#### What's new?

"For patients who need conservative treatment, there are new medications and types of injections," says Srikumaran, "and many new and exciting ways to address structural issues that we previously may not have been able to do, like novel implants or tendon transfer surgeries where we reroute certain muscles to assist in doing the job of a rotator cuff muscle that may not be able to be repaired directly." Athwal reports that "major advancements have occurred with minimally invasive surgeries and new implants." ■

#### Don't jump in

Dr. Uma Srikumaran says to give yourself a long, slow, steady ramp-up to your desired activity level to help avoid shoulder injuries related to sports or any new activity. "For example, it would be unwise to jump from a sedentary lifestyle to a new activity or exercise. Instead, ensure that you have good motion and flexibility of your shoulder and body in general by stretching and doing core exercises," he says.-DLM

#### Stretching it out

An easy way to stave off shoulder problems is to regularly stretch the muscles that support the joints. Dr. Uma Srikumaran, an

associate professor of orthopedic surgery at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, advises avoiding heavy, repetitive overhead lifting; he adds that if you're involved in sports or recreation, you should make sure the shoulder girdle is balanced-use good posture, using strong back and chest muscles—and keep the shoulder loose with stretching.-DLM



## At first blush

Taking steps to control rosacea

ore than 3 million Canadians are affected by rosacea, a chronic skin condition that causes redness and swelling, most commonly in the cheeks, nose, chin and forehead. It can start with short periods of redness or blushing, but may become longer-lasting and more visible. It is sometimes misdiagnosed as adult acne. More than half of those affected by one of the four forms of rosacea may have symptoms of the eye that include bloodshot eyes that feel gritty. While there is no known cure, symptoms can be reduced and managed through medication and lifestyle changes.

#### Who is affected?

Although men and women are equally likely to have rosacea, those between the ages of 45 and 60 years are most affected, as are those with fair skin, such as people of Northern and Eastern European descent. The true cause is unknown, but both genetic and environmental factors may play a part.

#### What can be done?

To avoid the many triggers of rosacea flare-ups, keep away from the following:

- Sunlight (use sunscreen)
- Alcohol
- Hot beverages, spicy foods, vinegar
- Use of topical alcohol- or acetonebased products or steroid creams
- Emotional stress
- Medications such as calcium channel blockers, niacin and sildenafil

Some medications may be helpful, such as certain oral antibiotics, topical antibiotics, azelaic acid, tretinoin or medications that cause blood vessels to constrict and reduce redness. In some cases, oral isotretinoin, most commonly used for acne, is prescribed, or laser therapy can be used to reduce red blood vessels.

If you or someone you know might be affected, recognizing this condition and getting help are the first steps toward regaining control of your life. For more information, visit the Acne and Rosacea Society of Canada at Rosaceahelp.ca.

#### **Emotional effects**

What can be worse than having rosacea is the misconceptions of others, such as the belief that

someone with rosacea has beyond embarrassment poor hygiene or drinks too much alcohol. It's no surprise that people with rosacea often deal with emotional problems

and low self-esteem. By avoiding triggers combined with the right treatment, the condition can be kept at bay.—*LV*







## Wonderful women

Jeannette Walls celebrates strong female characters who defy the odds

allie Kincaid, the main character of Jeannette Walls' new novel, *Hang the Moon*, sees the contradictions in life. As she says, "Legal and illegal and right and wrong don't always line up. Sometimes the so-called law is nothing but the haves telling the have-nots to stay in their place."

The book, set in western Virginia during Prohibition, tells the saga of the scandal-ridden Kincaid family. For Sallie, helping her povertystricken neighbours bootleg moonshine whiskey in defiance of the law not only makes business sense—her family's general store relies on the revenue from selling the contraband—but is also a moral calling. As Walls explains, speaking from her home in Virginia, "Appalachia has mountainous, rocky terrain, ill-suited for growing agricultural crops. People would have starved to death if they hadn't made moonshine. Besides, my own father ran bootleg liquor."

Walls says she is fascinated by this era in American history. "It was a transitional period from an agrarian to a modern society. The automobile broadened people's lives, especially those of women, offering greater freedom. Two amendments to the Constitution—one outlawing alcohol and the other giving women the vote—occurred simultaneously. This was a complex, contradictory time, and I liked that."

Walls' own life in some ways echoes that of her protagonist. Her family moved often during her childhood and experienced periods of homelessness. When they finally landed in rural Virginia, they lived in a three-room house without plumbing or heat. "I'll never forget when we first got electricity," Walls says, her voice full of wonder.

She captured this time in her 2005 bestselling memoir, *The Glass Castle*. The book has sold more than 5 million copies, has been translated into 31 languages, has received numerous awards and was made into a 2017 film starring Brie Larson and Woody Harrelson. Walls has also published two previous novels, *Half Broke Horses: A True-Life Novel*, based on the life of her grandmother, and *The Silver Star*.

"I'm drawn to stories about women who make their own way," Walls says. "In the early 20th century, women were gaining more independence, but there was also massive pushback. When I was doing research, I was appalled at the dismissal of women in popular culture, even downright hostility. They were being told to go back into the kitchen after having held down jobs and supported their families during World War I. I wanted to create a tough, feisty character in Sallie who could rise above all that."

When asked about the difference between writing fiction and non-fiction, Walls replies, "With non-fiction, you're writing about things that have happened. Writing fiction is like standing in the middle of the ocean. You can go in any direction. It can be overwhelming." To achieve realism, she continually asked herself, "Could this have happened. Is it plausible?"

Walls typically writes four to five hours daily, sometimes turning out 20 pages a day. "But then I rewrite. When I read something back and it doesn't sound right, I know I haven't gone deep enough. I love problem-solving, that euphoric feeling when I figure out how to make it work."

In other words, she's a born storyteller.

I wanted to write about what it felt like to be a Londoner then, and also what it was like to have a front-row seat at what felt, to many, like the biggest event of the century: the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II on June 2, 1953.

#### **CC** What else would you like readers to know about this book?

JR It may seem hard to believe, but I began work on Coronation Year in 2019 and had finished it several months before Queen Elizabeth's death last September. Like many Canadians, I cannot remember a world without her steady and reassuring presence, and I find myself reflecting on how much Canada, and the world in general, have changed since 1953.







"You see those commercials where the orders start coming in really fast and people are blowing into brown paper bags because they're hyperventilating? It was kind of like that," Joe jokes now. "We'd never heard of an order like that before. So we just put ourselves on high speed and never turned back."

While they attribute a lot of today's success to Costco's belief in their products, which range from lamb sticks, to beef sticks and jerky, to chicken sticks and even an Advent calendar for the holidays, much of it comes down to their own, er, dogged determination.

Founded in 2006 as a start-up run out of their garage and family room with their four children, The Crump Group now operates from a 130,000-square-foot facility and employs more than 400 people. "It's just not putting a bunch of stuff in the treats that the dogs don't need. It's about finding the best way to help pet parents feed their pets and giving them good options."




